What To Bring:

Directions:

From Milwaukee (45 miles) I-43 South to
Hwy 20 at Exit 38 (East Troy);
turn right onto Hwy 20 and follow to second four way stop;
turn right onto Hwy 12 West and go to County Road O;
turn left and go for 1 mile;
turn right onto Kettle Moraine Drive;
follow across County Road P (bank on corner);
entrance 0.2 miles on left.

Activities with additional cost:

Paintball – \$5 for a round includes equipment and 50 rounds of paintballs

Rifle Range – \$3 for 25 rounds

Trap Shooting – \$1 per shot for ammo and pigeon (no cost if you have your own supplies)

Activities available at no additional cost:

Sky glide, 360 degree swing, Pontoon boat rides, Maze, Sand volleyball, Gym (basketball or volleyball), and Fireside room activities (pool, ping pong, etc.)
