- "We affirm that Scripture, having been given by divine inspiration, is infallible, so that, far from misleading us, it is true and reliable in all the matters it addresses."

# THE CANON: Who is the Authority?



- Luke 11:50 so that the blood of all the prophets, shed since the foundation of the world, may be charged against this generation, 51 from the blood of Abel [Genesis] to the blood of Zechariah [2 Chronicles], who was killed between the altar and the house of God; yes, I tell you, it shall be charged against this generation.'


- PRAY: Acts 6:4 "But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word."
- **HEAR: 1 Thessalonians 2:13** For this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men, but for what it really is, the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe.
- **EAT: Psalms 19:10** They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb.
- DO: James 1:22 But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.
- **WORSHIP: 1 Timothy 4:13** Until I come, give attention to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation and teaching.

- **DILIGENT: 2 Timothy 2:15** Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.
- PROCLAIM (Believers): 2 Timothy 4:2 preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.

  ENGAGE (Unbelievers): Acts 17:2 Then Paul, as his custom was, went in to them, and for three Sabbaths reasoned with them from the Scriptures, 3 explaining and demonstrating that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead, and saying, "This Jesus whom I preach to you is the Christ." 4 And some of them were persuaded; and a great multitude of the devout Greeks, and not a few of the leading women, joined Paul and Silas.
- ENTRUST: 2 Timothy 2:2 And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.
- REVERE: Isaiah 66:2 "For My hand made all these things, Thus all these things came into being," declares the Lord. "But to this one I will look, To him who is humble and contrite of spirit, and who trembles at My word.

#### Scientific

- Job 26:8 "He wraps up the waters in His clouds, And the cloud does not burst under them.
- Job 36:27 "For He draws up the drops of water, They distill rain from the mist, 28 Which the clouds pour down, They drip upon man abundantly.
- Job 37:16 "Do you know about the layers of the thick clouds, The wonders
  of one perfect in knowledge,
- Psalms 135:7 He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; Who makes lightnings for the rain, Who brings forth the wind from His treasuries.
- Isaiah 40:22 It is He who sits above the circle of the earth, And its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, Who stretches out the heavens like a curtain And spreads them out like a tent to dwell in.
- Job 26:7 "He stretches out the north over empty space And hangs the earth on nothing.

### **EVIDENCE THE BIBLE IS TRUE**

- Archeology / Geology Jericho (Archaeologist discoveries 1860s-1960s)
- Prophecy
  - Daniel (605–536 BC) / (Medo-Persia (539–331 BC), Greece (331– 146 BC), Rome (146 BC–476 AD), Jesus 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming.
  - Cyrus (538 BC) in Isaiah 44:28 (739–686 BC) (~150 Years before)
- Practical Describes the condition of man, his sin, portrays writers in negative light.

# **OTHER QUESTIONS**

- New Revelation? No
  - Criteria: Does not contradict, Apostle, Prophet, Directly Connected
  - Ephesians 2:20 having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, 21 in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, 22 in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.
- Bible Full of Contradictions:
  - Can you show me two or three you found? There are no contradictions, and the context will clear up your confusion.

**2 Peter 1:20** But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, **21** for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

**Matthew 4:4** But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live on Bread Alone, But on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.'"
