Location and Timing between Jesus' Baptism and First Miracle	
Day 1 (John 1:19-28)	Bethany beyond the Jordan: John testifies that he is the "voice of one crying in the wilderness" (Isa 40:3-5)
Day 2 (John 1:29-34; 1:29, "The next day...")	Bethany beyond the Jordan: John declares Jesus to be the Lamb of God and reflects on Jesus' baptism
Day 3 (John 1:35-42; 1:35, "The next day...")	Bethany beyond the Jordan: Jesus calls Andrew and Peter
Day 4 (John 1:43-51; 1:43, "The next day...")	Bethsaida: Jesus calls Philip and Nathanael
Day 5 (implied)	Cana of Galilee: Jesus travels from Bethsaida to Cana
Day 6 (John 2:1-11; 1:11, "The next day...")	Cana of Galilee: Jesus changes water to wine





**Sea of Galilee Boat or Jesus Boat**



- Discovered in January 1986 on the shores of the Sea of Galilee by two fishermen
- Severe drought caused the sea to recede several meters exposing more shoreline
- Construction found to be "shell first," primarily cedar planks and oak frames with tarson joinery
- Capacity: 15 Crew: 5
- Primarily for fishing; may have carried passengers and goods
- Important discovery toward learning about boats used on the Sea of Galilee during the Roman Empire

**Full size:**  
 length: 26.5 ft  
 width: 7.5 ft  
 depth: 4.5 ft

This was the first ancient boat discovered in the Sea of Galilee and is believed to have been built between 100 BC and 100 AD.

Jesus and his followers may have used this type of boat.
